**THE KING'S ACADEMY** was established in 1999 as an independent Christian school that partners with parents in a new approach to education. TKA equips students for life by requiring academic excellence, promoting Christian character, and encouraging self-discipline and self-motivation. The campus is located on 18 acres and serves a student body of approximately 675 students in grades K – 8, and 427 students in grades 9 - 12. The Class of 2024 was made up of 87 graduating seniors.

**THE FACULTY** for our high school includes 35 men and women, each of which holds at least a bachelor's degree. 20% of our faculty holds a master's or higher degree. The average class size is 21.

**THE SCHOOL** is accredited by Cognia (formerly named AdvancED/SACS).

**THE CURRICULUM** at TKA is academically challenging; therefore, TKA only offers seven honors classes. Due to our educational partnership with parents, our students are well prepared for the college experience. Many of our seniors dual enroll at local colleges, such as Kennesaw State University and Chattahoochee Technical College.

### GRADING AND RANKING

The TKA school year is divided into two semesters. Six academic courses is the minimum required

each semester, except during the senior year when four are required. All grades are recorded on the transcript, including repeated courses. Dual enrollment grades are weighted with the addition of 10 points for semester averages, and a college grade of "A" is weighted with an additional quality point. Honors grades are weighted with the addition of 5 points to the semester average and an additional .5 quality point. Given the nature of the school and the small size of the senior class, TKA does not rank its students.

### CLASS AVERAGES

The average SAT score for the class of 2024 was 1160, scoring above 67% of juniors and seniors nationally. The average ACT score is 25, scoring above 74% of juniors and seniors nationally.
