FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

It is important to us that families with various income levels are able to apply and to attend TKA, therefore we try to keep costs as low as possible. Because the yearly budget is based on the total number of students enrolled, parents are expected to financially commit to the program for the entire school year.

BILLING

Year In Full and staff tuition discounts do not apply to JROTC tuition.

Existing TKA Families

JROTC Tuition and fees will be billed to your existing FACTS account and will be applied to your current FACTS tuition management plan.

New TKA Part Time JROTC Families

You will be required to sign up for a FACTS tuition management plan. We recommend that you sign up for the monthly plan. This will divide your tuition balance among monthly payments.

Students will pay a re-enrollment fee each January to remain in the program for the next school year. This fee will be \$100 for 2024 - 2025

PRIORITY DEADLINES

June 30, 2023

Please complete your application for admission by June 30th. This includes paying any applicable enrollment fees and submitting the application for admission online.

Early July 2023

We will hold family interviews during this month. Once you complete your application you will receive an invitation to sign up for a short interview.

Late July

We will send acceptance letters with instructions for setting up payment plans and enrollment information. TKA part-time families will be required to create FACTS parents web accounts and complete web forms with emergency contact information and medical information.

We will operate rolling admissions for students who are interested in enrolling after our priority deadlines.

January 2024

Re-Enrollment fees are due in January. This fee will need to be paid for your student to be enrolled again the following fall.

FACTS TUITION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The King's Academy utilizes the FACTS Tuition Management system to bill and collect payments for tuition. Each family has more flexibility with this system to choose their number of payments and payment dates, as well as the ability to have your payments auto-drawn from a bank account or a credit card. FACTS Management notifies families through email about upcoming payments due or questions about a payment attempt. Please check your email account regularly, especially around your payment due date. You will also be able to log in to your FACTS account and make a payment toward tuition or incidentals at any time.

FAMILY FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

We require that all families pay yearly tuition through our online payment system. Families can choose between an annual payment, semester payments or monthly payments. After the withdrawal deadline, TKA families are committed to paying a yearly tuition amount for all enrolled students, regardless of payment plan. Early withdrawal does not release families from this commitment.

NEW JROTC FAMILY APPLICATION CHECKLIST

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Compile a homeschool curriculum worksheet. Families will be required to upload curriculum and report cards to the online application.
- Gather birth certificate, custody documents and immunization records (to be submitted online with the Application).
- Begin completing the application for admission.
- Each custodial parent complete Parent Questionnaire.
- Enrolling Student complete Student Questionnaire.
- Collect contact info (email & phone number) for 1 spiritual reference and 1 academic reference (to be submitted online with the application). No family members will be accepted as references.
- Contact your references to let them know that they will be contacted by our school.
- Submit Fees Online (Please be prepared to pay credit card fees determined by your card issuer).
 - Submit a Non-refundable Application Fee (\$100). If you are applying any additional siblings the Application Fee is reduced to \$35 for each additional applicant.
 - Submit a \$400 enrollment fee for each applicant. (This amount non-refundable if you end the application process early or you decline the placement of your student. This fee is only refunded if TKA does not place your student.) This includes a \$200 tuition deposit that will be applied to the first tuition payment.
- Complete the Online Application (Applications Due June 30)

THE EVALUATIVE PROCESS

- Family Interview – You will receive a scheduling email to sign up for a mandatory family interview. All applicant students and all custodial parents are required to attend.
- References – We will contact references by phone or email

STATEMENT OF FAITH



Our Statement of Faith is based on fundamental Christian beliefs that we strongly support as the primary doctrine for teaching. TKA does not promote or endorse any particular denomination. We maintain this position for the purpose of unity and fairness to each student. Other doctrinal issues upon which this ministry has no official stance will be secondary doctrine and will not be taught. In the event secondary doctrine is brought up, students will be referred back to the family and church for final authority. We desire to remain united in the salvation and love of Christ, avoiding any dissension that may be caused by denominational distinctives. The King's Academy does not accept families from a non-Christian background or from denominations that do not adhere to the following doctrinal distinctives:

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (II Tim 3:15; II Pet 1:21). The Bible speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, and it is the sole and final source of all that we believe. For purposes of The King's Academy's faith, doctrine, practice, policy, and discipline, our School Board is The King's Academy's final interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application.
- We believe there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Gen 1:1; Matt 28:19; John 10:30).
- We believe in the deity of Christ (John 10:33); His virgin birth (Is 7:14; Matt 1:23; Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Heb 4:15; 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Cor 15:3; Eph 1:7; Heb 2:9); His resurrection (John 11:25; I Cor 15:4); His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11; Rev 19:11).
- We believe that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone we are saved (John 3:16-19; 5:24; Rom 3:23; 5:8-9; Eph 2:8-10; Tit 3:5).
- We believe that God offers redemption and restoration to all who confess and forsake their sin, seeking His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ (Acts 3:19-21; Rom 10:9-10; 1 Cor 6:9-11).
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28, 29).
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Rom 8:9; I Cor 12:12-13; Gal 3:26, 28).
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life (Rom 8:13-14; I Cor 3:16; 6:19-20; Eph 4:30; 5:18).
- We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity (Mark 12:28-31; Luke 6:31). Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture nor the doctrines of The King's Academy
- We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life (Ps 139).
- We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Gen 1:26-27). Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.
- We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. (Gen 2:18-25). We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other (1 Cor 6:18; 7:2-5; Heb 13:4). We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman.
- We believe that any form of sexual immorality, including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography is sinful (Matt 15:18-20; 1 Cor 6:9-10).
