- To try out for a team, the girls <u>must attend at least one tryout</u>. It is preferred that the girls attend both tryouts.
- If we have enough middle school girls try out, we will have two teams like we did last year. We will have a Blue team and a Silver team.
- ➤ Blue Team: girls from 6th through 8th grade. These girls will be the stronger players in this age group and they will play a GAPPS schedule. Head Coach TBD.
- ➤ Silver Team: girls in the 6th and 7th grade. No 8th graders will play on this team. This team will be more of a developmental team to teach the game to our girls who may not have as much experience. This team will play an independent schedule. Head Coach Tamela Camp
- ➤ High School teams: we plan to have a Junior Varsity and a Varsity Team. The Varsity can be made up of 9th 12th grade girls. The Junior Varsity can be made up of 9th 11th grade girls. There will be no 12th graders on the Junior Varsity. The Varsity will play a GIAA schedule and the Junior Varsity will play an independent schedule. Danielle Tillery will be the Varsity Head Coach. Wes Richard will be the JV Head Coach.
- Players must be enrolled at TKA, have a letter of acceptance or be an AES (Alternatively Educated Student, i.e. Homeschooled student) in order to try out for any volleyball team. AES must be approved by TKA Athletic Department and GAPPS (MS) or GIAA (HS) prior to tryouts. Students who are applying to get into TKA and who have not received their acceptance letter are not eligible to try out until they have been accepted into the school. Per TKA rules, TKA is not permitted to keep AES players and cut students who attend TKA.
- ▶ Players must attend the grade appropriate tryouts for their team (MS grades 6th-8th and HS grades 9th-12th). If it is necessary, 8th graders could be pulled up to play on a high school team, but that decision will be made by the coaches and Athletic Director and approved by the parents of that player. Tryouts are closed to everyone except coaches, players and Athletic Department Staff.

RESULTS

Rostered players will receive an email from the coach followed by an email from the Athletic Department with the link to register for the Fall 2025 season.

SPORTS PHYSICALS & FORMS

Students are REQUIRED to have a current physical form on file in the Athletic Department prior to participating in tryouts that indicates that the student is physically approved for participation. (Note: If your child receives a physical after April 1st, it will be good for the entire following school year.)
