HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY POLICY

Participants and parents must acknowledge acceptance of our statement of faith and code of conduct by signing the application forms included in the participant packet for each program.

A student must not have reached his/her 19th birthday prior to May 1st, preceding their year of participation. Students have eight consecutive semesters or four consecutive years of eligibility from the date of entry into the 9th grade. This means that once a student designates, they are a high school student, their eligibility clock starts ticking. (Please note that 8th grade students not attending The Kings Academy may take high school level courses and not be considered a 9th grader.)

Students not attending The Kings Academy must remain living at home, and if taking college courses, must also be dually enrolled in HOMESCHOOL studies.

Players will be publicly recognized and awarded as seniors only once at Knights' events and must not "walk" during Senior Recognition at games or banquets until they are graduating from high school.

Seniors are required to complete an Exit Agreement form, and this will serve as a binding contract that their participation with The Kings Academy Athletic program has ended.

We acknowledge that we have read The Kings Academy Athletic Eligibility Policy and agree to abide by these guidelines. We understand that according to this policy, the above-named student's eligibility to participate in this Athletic program will end once this season is completed.
