



MIDDLE SCHOOL Affidavit of Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in middle school interscholastic activities, a student must not have reached his 15th birthday prior to September 1st, in the year of participation. An AES athlete will have a "home base" school that he/she will be eligible for the duration of his/her eligibility. AES athletes must live within a 30-mile radius of the GAPPS "home base" school. Students have eight consecutive semesters or four consecutive years of eligibility from the date of entry into the 9th grade. This means that once a student designates that he/she is a high school student (9th grade), his/her eligibility clock starts ticking.
